English – Reading

(You must complete this activity)

- Read with an adult at home three times a week or more.
- OPTIONAL- Borrow a book from your local library.
- OPTIONAL – Read a book at home and write one sentence to say if you liked it and why.

ART/DT

- Make a printed picture at home using paint and objects like sponges, potatoes, or Lego.
- Draw a windmill and label the parts that move in the wind.

Science

- Touch different objects and say if they are hard, soft, smooth, or rough.
- Draw a person and label the main body parts (head, arms, legs, hands, feet).
- Talk to an adult about one thing you do to keep your body healthy, such as eating fruit, exercising, or sleeping well.

History / Geography

- Act out the weather using your body (blowing wind, falling rain, hot sunshine).
- Create a weather wheel that you can turn to show today's weather.
- Draw or dress a toy in clothes for different types of weather.
- Make a toy using junk materials, like children did in the past.
