At Poulton St Chad's CofE Primary School a bully is defined as someone who hurts someone more than once (constantly). A bully is also someone who deliberately uses behaviour which is meant to hurt, frighten or upset another person.

### Types of Bullying

**Emotional:** Hurting people's feelings, leaving you out, making you feel bad.

**Physical:** Punching, kicking, spitting, pushing, theft.

**Verbal:** Being teased, name calling, being rude.

**Racist:** Calling you racist names, graffiti.

**Cyber:** Saying unkind things by text, email, social media.

Remember that you may say something to someone to try and be funny but they may not think that it is funny and it may actually be hurtful to that person.

### If you are bullied:

#### Do

- ✓ Ask them to stop if you can.
- ✓ Use eye contact and say stop
- ✓ Ignore them.
- ✓ Walk away.
- ✓ **ALWAYS TELL AN ADULT AT SCHOOL. THE QUICKER YOU TELL SOMEONE, THE QUICKER THEY CAN HELP.**



#### DON'T

- ✗ Do what they say.
- ✗ Get angry and retaliate.
- ✗ Hit them.
- ✗ Think that it is your fault.
- ✗ Hide it from everyone.

### What should I do if I see someone else being bullied?

- Don't walk away and ignore the bullying.
- Tell the bully to stop if it is safe to do so.
- Don't stay silent or the bullying will keep happening.
- Don't lose your temper.
