Mathematics

(You must complete this activity)

Multiplication practice, children are tested weekly with books being returned home.

Additional home learning tasks will be sent home weekly, these link to our current Powermaths Topic

English – Writing, GPS or Spelling

(You must complete this activity)

Home learning tasks will be sent home weekly with a link to our current English topic. These may be SPaG focused, comprehension activities or writing tasks.

OPTIONAL: Create your own twist on a traditional folktale by changing the ending, bring it in to read to the class.

English – Reading

(You must complete this activity)

Regular reading of your class/school library book, bring in your planner signed three times on Friday!

OPTIONAL: Visit a library and pick out a book that you are interested in.

OPTIONAL: Write a review of a book you have enjoyed reading over the Summer.

ART/DT

Learn about an artist that works with charcoal, pick out a favourite piece by them and share it with the class.

Imagine and design your own pneumatic device to solve a problem in your life. Draw and label your design and present it to the class.

French

Learn to count in French, see how high you can get!

Learn a French song and sing it to the class!

Visit a local library and see if there are any French books (we have some in the school library), which words can you recognise?

Science

Investigate how light is reflected from different surfaces around your home. Create a list of transparent, translucent, opaque and reflective surfaces and present it in class!

Experiment with shadow puppets, what happens when you move your hand closer to/further away from the light source?

History/Geography

Create your own map of a familiar location, include a key to mark important things/places

Use grid references to create your own puzzle, can we locate the town/city using it's grid reference?

Create a presentation on the things the Romans left behind, what was their impact on Britain?

Create a timeline of the Roman's time in Britian, make sure to include key dates!

R.E

Learn about a Harvest Festival celebrated by another culture, consider what they do differently and present your findings to the class.

Write your own Harvest prayer.

Learn about a charity which helps to support people who need food or shelter, create a poster about them which can be placed around the school.
