## Science

Draw a picture and create a fact file about when it is young and when it is an adult.

## History/Geography

History – Do you have a family member who is/was a nurse? Ask to interview them about their role. Prepare questions to compare their experiences with nursing in the Victorian era.

Geography – Draw and label an aerial picture of your local area. Try to show both human features (like houses or roads) and physical features (like trees or rivers).

- Select a **minimum of two** topic activities to complete. You can choose which activities you find the most interesting.
