Mathematics

(You must complete this activity)

- Create a bright vibrant poster explaining what you have been learning about during our Place Value and Roman Numerals unit.
- Include examples showing the value of digits in different places and how numbers can be written using Roman numerals.
- Activities will also be set on SumDog if children have access at home.

English – Reading

(You must complete this activity)

- Choose a Legend from the British Isles and write 6 interesting or unfamiliar words and find out what they mean.
- Write a short summary of the legend in your own words including your favourite part and why you enjoyed it.

English – SPAG

(You must complete this activity)

- Find 10 interesting words related to legends and for each word write a synonym and an antonym.
- Then pick 5 of your words and use them in your own sentences.
- Can you improve a simple sentence story by replacing a word with a more interesting synonym?

PSHE

- Create a 'How to be a Great Role Model' poster or fact file.
- Think about what makes someone a good role model, what they could do to inspire others and how can you show kindness, respect, honesty or responsibility.

Art/DT

- Choose a word that has a strong meaning, such as power, ocean, fire, adventure, kindness, etc.
- Experiment with different fonts, letter shapes and sizes.
- Use colour, patterns, textures or illustration to bring the word to life.
- Think about how the design of your letters can show the meaning of the word.

Science

- Create an informative poster explaining what you have learned about forces.
- Include examples such as pushes and pulls, friction and gravity.
- Add labelled diagrams or examples from everyday life to show how forces affect objects.

History/Geography

- Research into mountains and create a non-chronological report about your findings.
- Include information about how mountains are formed, mountain ranges, famous mountains and life in mountainous areas.
- Then create your own interpretation of a mountain landscape through drawing, painting, collage, junk modelling, Lego or another medium.

R.E

- Choose a world faith and research one of its sacred texts.
- Find out what the sacred text is called, which faith it belongs to, what it teaches, and why it is important to believers.
- Present your findings as a poster, information booklet, artwork, or other creative format.

- You must **complete all the core activities** above (Mathematics, English and Reading)
- Select a **minimum of two** topic activities to complete. You can choose which activities you find the most interesting.
- **Presentation must be your best!**
